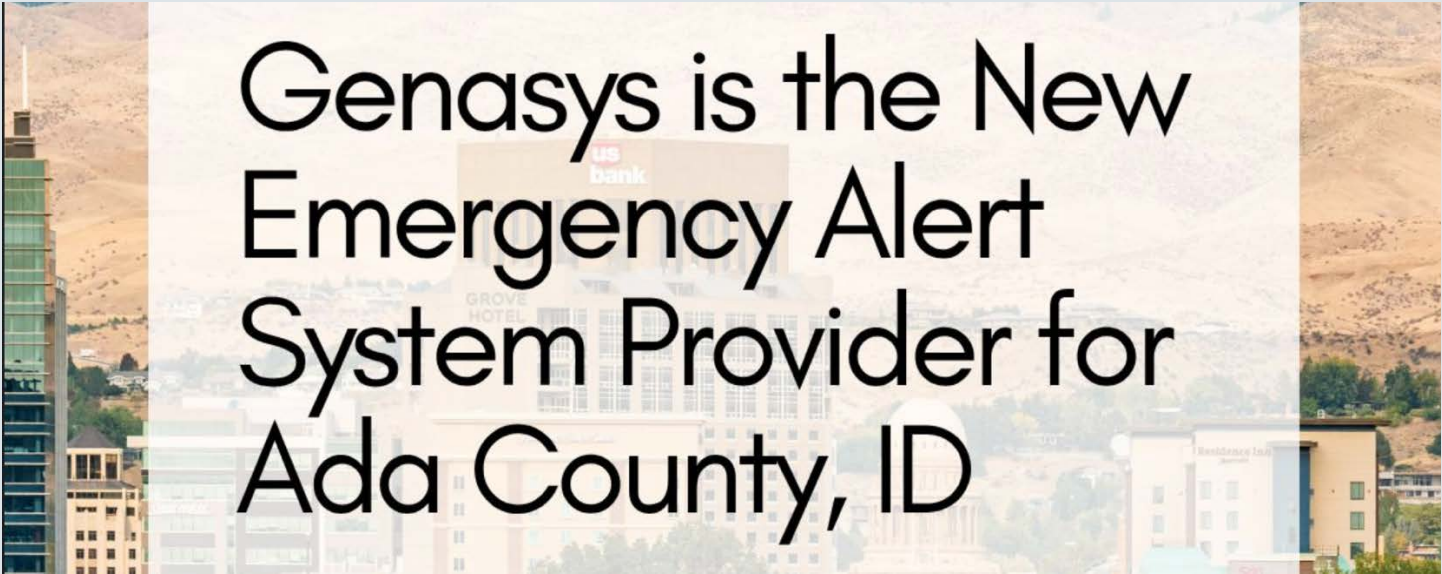
Evertel Integration Can Transform Distribution of Critical Intelligence from Real-Time Crime and Fusion Centers

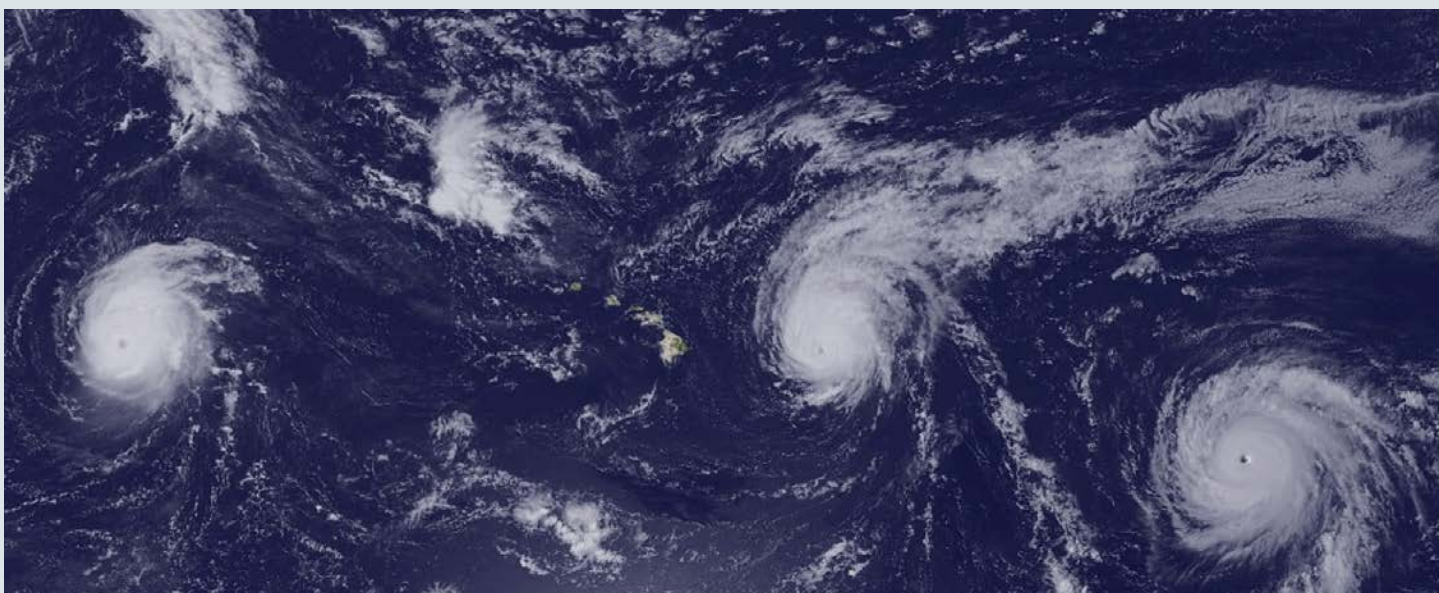
Idaho's Most Populous County Selects Genasys Protect

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Above Normal Hurricane Season Forecast for Maui – Be Prepared

Hurricane season in Hawaii is June 1 through November 30, and with an above-normal season forecast — including five to 13 tropical cyclones in the Central Pacific — County of Maui and Maui Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) officials are urging residents and visitors to prepare well before a storm is on the horizon.

“NOAA forecasters say the tropical Pacific could experience moderate to strong El Niño conditions, which are typically linked to increased tropical cyclone activity in Hawai‘i’s Central Pacific region,” MEMA Administrator Amos Lonokailua-Hewett said.

Being informed before and during a storm is just as important as having the right supplies in go bags. MEMA recommends downloading the **Genasys Protect** app for evacuation updates and hazard alerts at protect.genasys.com.

City of Sedona, AZ Installs Genasys Acoustics Emergency Warning Systems

The city of Sedona recently enhanced community safety with the installation of three new outdoor warning systems that will activate when needed to broadcast emergency notifications.

The emergency warning systems are intended to provide critical emergency information during incidents such as wildfires, flash floods, law enforcement emergencies, and other critical situations. Importantly, the systems will help notify residents and visitors who may not have reliable cellular service, internet access, or emergency alerts enabled on their devices. The three installations also serve as a pilot project to test the viability of future additional systems in other parts of Sedona.

The network of modern systems is capable of spoken voice messaging for clear emergency instructions, audible warning tones for rapid public notification, and remote silent testing of the system. This allows the city to test the functionality of the siren at no volume so that there aren't disruptions to the neighborhood.

In the event of local or area-wide power failures, the Genasys installations continue to operate on solar power.

Beverly Hills Fire Department Alerts Residents of Genasys Protect Evacuation Zones

The Beverly Hills Fire Department and the volunteer group, Just in Case BH, is ensuring the community is aware of their geographic zone they are part of in case of an emergency.

The city of Beverly Hills has been divided into nine zones that cover every neighborhood and are used by emergency services to communicate evacuation orders, traffic control points, and information during an emergency.

One of the major aspects of Just in Case BH is the division of the city into geographic zones, aligning with the State of California and the **Genasys Protect** nomenclature.

"Preparedness is a shared responsibility," said Beverly Hills Fire Chief Greg Barton. "It's important our residents know what zone they are part of that may be referenced during an evacuation order or emergency."

Spokane County, WA to Purchase LRAD with DHS Grant

Spokane County Commissioners unanimously accepted a \$726,000 grant from the Department of Homeland Security last month to help boost security capabilities ahead of the FIFA World Cup.

Egypt's national soccer team will be based in Spokane as they prepare for games on the West Coast.

The county is using part of the grant to purchase a **Long Range Acoustic Device**, which can broadcast emergency messages to large crowds during critical incidents.

LRAD Deployed in Search for Trapped Construction Workers

Rescuers from the local government, the Department of Public Works and Highways, and the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) raced to save dozens of construction workers trapped in an immense pile of rubble. It was all that remained after a nine-story hotel collapsed while under construction last month in a city north of Manila following heavy rains.

The Search and Rescue team used a **Long Range Acoustic Device** (LRAD), a specialized, high-powered directional loudspeaker, to call out to any survivors trapped in the rubble to yell or make noise so the team could locate them.
